COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course takes a systems approach comparing ecological regions in Montana and the science behind the conservation and management of wildlife species endemic to these regions. Coursework incorporates hands-on field experiences and project based activities. Participants will learn about topics related to the unique ecology and habitats of the regions with emphasis on landscape investigations and associated management issues regarding plants and animals.

COURSE LOCATION:

The 6,000-acre Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch (TRMR) is located northwest of Great Falls, Montana, in a unique ecotone between the Rocky Mountains, adjoining foothills, and the expansive short-grass prairie to the east. The TRMR, owned by the Boone and Crockett Club, operates as a working cattle ranch. Research, education, and demonstration projects in wildlife conservation and integrated livestock and land management are conducted in association with the College of Forestry and Conservation at the University of Montana.

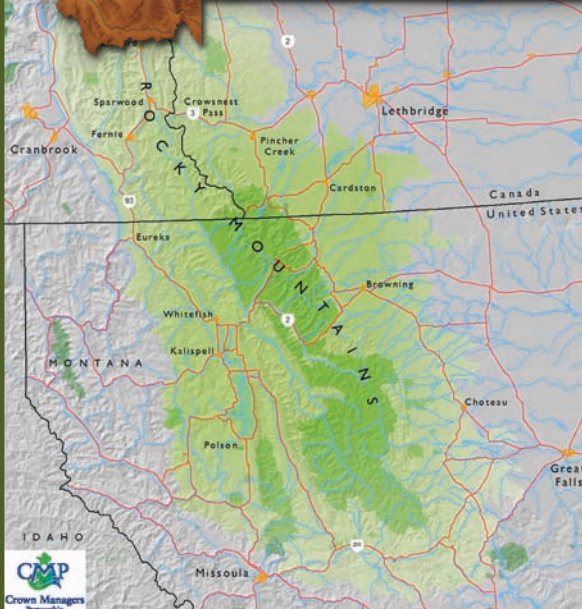
COST: \$570

- \$250 registration fee due with application by May 31, 2012. (If applicant cancels before the cancellation deadline of May 30, 2011, course fee minus a processing fee of \$35 will be reimbursed.)
- \$320 balance is due the first day of the course.

COURSE LIMIT: 16 participants

CREDIT: 3 credits pending approval from UM-Missoula. Credit fee is separate from course fee and will be payable to the university.
