

MOHAB is based out of the Elmer Rasmuson Wildlife Conservation Center (ERWCC) on the Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch (TRMR).

The 6,000 acre ranch lies in the foothills of the east slope of the Rocky Mountains near Dupuyer, Montana. The property abuts thousands of acres of national forest and Wilderness containing prime habitat for elk, mule deer, whitetail deer, cougar, among other small mammals and birds. Grizzly and black bears frequently use this property and bighorn sheep and Rocky Mountain goats occur in adjacent national forest lands.

The Ranch and ERWCC serves as the base of operations for MOHAB. Crews - 12 persons per crew - depart the base for pre-established treks into the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex, a 1,500,000-acre Wilderness area located west of the TRMR and ERWCC.

The "Bob" straddles the Continental Divide with elevations ranging from 4,000 feet along the valley floors to more than 9,000 feet at mountain summits. This vast Wilderness is approximately seven times larger than Philmont with established trails. Three trailheads to the "Bob" are within walking and driving distance of the Ranch property.

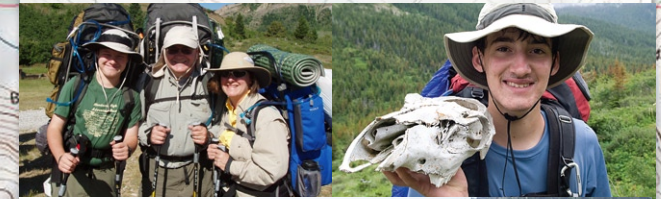

Front Country Programs PRIOR to Backcountry Trek:

- **Lay of the Land** - This program is part of your crew's first exposure to MOHAB. The history of the Boone and Crockett Club, their purpose and mission is part of this program as well as TRM Ranch and ERWCC operations. An introduction to the Rocky Mountain Front Range ecosystem, cultural history, the Bob Marshall Wilderness area and its fish and wildlife is the primary focus.
- **Map, Compass & GPS** - Learn how to orient yourself using local maps, compass, and GPS to navigate across the landscape. Learn which maps best fit your trek needs by understanding how to read the map, map scale, and how to orient yourself.
- **Be Bear Aware** - Northwestern Montana and the Bob Marshall Wilderness have both Black and Grizzly bears. The objective of this training is to ensure crews know how to be safe in bear country and what to do to reduce human vs. bear conflicts.
- **Leave No Trace** - This training is specific to hiking and camping in the Bob Marshall Wilderness complex provides participants hands on experience in Leave No Trace principles, skills and techniques.

Front Country Programs AFTER Backcountry Trek:

(dependent on the number of days in backcountry):

- **Tracks, Scat & Signs** - Wild animals are elusive and hard to observe in wild places, but you can discover behaviors from signs they leave behind. Learn observational skills that might tell you which animals are living in the various habitats around the TRMR and in the Wilderness.
- **Fly Fishing** - Learn to fly fish, identify fish of Montana, where to find each species and the rules and regulations governing game fish in Montana. Depending on the size and type you catch, you might have fish for dinner!
- **Shooting Range** - Hone your technique or acquire new marksmanship skills at our shooting range. Join NRA certified instructors to learn about the equipment, safety issues, and ethics for hunting and target shooting activities.

Backcountry Program

- Once your crew leader has made reservations, MOHAB staff provide assistance in suggesting several available route opportunities or offer assistance if a crew elects to build their own.
- All treks are in the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex, adjacent to base camp at the Ranch.
- Your trek will be based on three questions:
 - 1- What does your crew want to do in the backcountry?
 - 2- How many days (4, 4.5, or 5) does your crew want to spend on the trail?
 - 3- What is your crew's previous backpacking experience?
